



Anderson Trucking to add 10,000 square feet

St. Cloud-based Anderson Trucking Service Inc. announced Friday that it is expanding its corporate office at 725 Opportunity Drive to accommodate growth.

The 10,000-square-foot expansion to two floors of its corporate office will be filled with 200 additional seats and six new conference rooms. Construction is expected to be completed in spring of 2017.

Planning for the new addition started in the fall of 2015, according to a news release.

August marks the 10th year ATS will have been in its current corporate headquarters. ATS built its two-story, 60,000-square-foot office and training center near Interstate Highway 94 in 2005-06. Previously, the company had been headquartered near the corner of Cooper Avenue and Third Street North.

"It's exciting for us at Anderson Trucking Service and for the community that the growth of ATS continues to be strong well after the company's 60th anniversary," said Director of Facilities Scott Follett in a press release.

McGough Construction will be contracting the expansion.

ATS is the largest truckload carrier in Minnesota and the 38th largest for-hire carrier in North America, operating more than 2,400 tractors and 8,600 trailers. The company, founded in 1955, serves all of North America (including Hawaii and Puerto Rico), as well the Caribbean, Germany and other international points.
