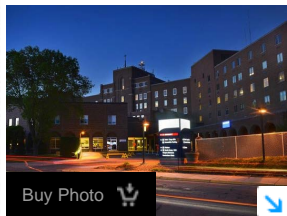

St. Cloud Hospital is ranked third among about 150 hospitals in Minnesota, behind Mayo Clinic in Rochester and Abbott Northwestern Hospital in Minneapolis, according to US News & World Report.

About 3 percent of hospitals in the nation — a total of 137 — earned a national ranking in at least one specialty. US News & World Report also ranked St. Cloud Hospital as “high performing” in six specialties, including: diabetes & endocrinology, geriatrics, nephrology, neurology & neurosurgery, pulmonology, and urology.

The annual rankings include nearly 5,000 medical centers across the country. The publication ranks hospitals as a tool for consumers. The rankings are based on safety and other measures as well as a survey of physicians from across the United States.
