The Greater St. Cloud Development Corp. has released the names of its 2015 Innovation Award winners.

Rejuv Medical and Park Industries have received the for-profit Innovation Awards.

Rejuv Medical has been recognized as an innovative emerging company for the development of its regenerative medical and business model. The Waite Park-based facility specializes in regenerative orthopedics, functional medicine and the integration of fitness into medical treatments.

The established company Innovation Award has been given to Park Industries for their development of the Fusion CNC Saw/Waterjet used in granite and quartz fabrication. The Fusion CNC Saw/Waterjet uses computer numerical control technology from other industries to improve material handling in the stone industry.

The GSDC also named Anna Marie's Alliance and Catholic Charities of the Diocese of St. Cloud the 2015 recipients of its nonprofit Innovation Award.

Anna Marie's Alliance has been recognized for its work in developing the first on-site Pet Safe Home/Learning Center in Minnesota. This facility provides shelter for pets involved in domestically violent relationships.

Catholic Charities has been awarded the nonprofit Innovation Award for its work with the Emergency Services Mobile Food Shelf. This project has helped serve about 100 households a month since the project started in June 2014.

All four organizations will receive \$1,000 and will be recognized at the GSDC's Innovation Summit from 7:30 a.m.-1 p.m Oct. 8 at River's Edge Convention Center.

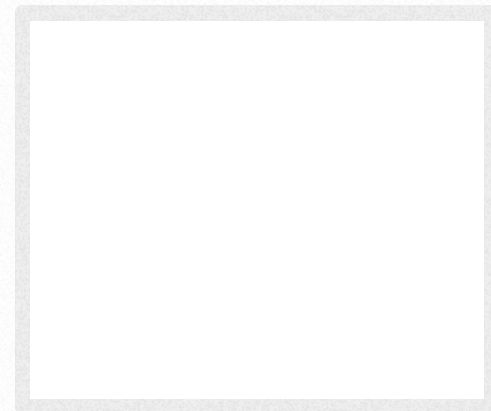
